- The abstract must contain a minimum of 250 words.
- The full paper (maximum 10 pages) should be submitted via email to: icssrsrcgfgckkp@gmail.com
- All submitted manuscripts will undergo a double-blind peer review process conducted by the Review Committee.
- All submissions must be original, unpublished and free from plagiarism, including AI-generated plagiarism.
- Papers will be evaluated based on quality, originality, relevance, and other academic criteria.
- Papers must be submitted in soft copy (MS Word format) using Times New Roman, 12-point font size, 1.5 line spacing, and one-inch margins on all sides, with a maximum length of 10 pages.
- Research papers should preferably follow the standard research format, including need for the study, objectives, hypothesis (if any), methodology, data analysis, findings, conclusion, references (APA format must be strictly followed).
- Registration must be completed separately by the author and co-authors.
- Certificates will be issued to co-authors only upon independent registration and payment.
- Publication charges will be applicable. (Rs 1200 for UGC Care listed Journal with ISSN No)

- Walk-in registration is permitted.
