The Southern Regional Centre, ICSSR announces a **Seven days Faculty Development Programme for young faculty in Social Sciences** in Collaboration with Department of Studies and Research in Sociology, Karnataka State Open University from 16/10/2023 to 22/10/2023. Interested candidates may apply online through our Website ICSSR-SRC or Karnataka State Open University.

Last date to apply is **05/10/2023**, course intake is limited to **40 faculty members only**.

Eligibility:

1. Young faculty members with less than 8 years of service from Government degree colleges, Government aided degree colleges and Private degree/PG colleges (on roll) in the state of Karnataka are eligible to apply for this faculty development programme.
2. The candidates who have under gone similar training/courses earlier are not eligible to apply again.

1. A total of 40 young faculty members in the social sciences disciplines will be selected from Government degree colleges, Government aided degree colleges and Private degree/PG colleges (on roll) in the state of Karnataka on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. The aspects like representation of different Social Science Disciplines, Social Background, Gender, etc., shall also be taken into consideration while selecting the candidates.

4. The selected outstation candidates will be provided with free accommodation and food during the course period.
