Last date to apply is **05/10/2023**, course intake is limited to **40 faculty members only**.

Eligibility:

- Young faculty members with less than 8 years of service from Government degree colleges, Government aided degree colleges and Private degree/PG colleges (on roll) in the state of Karnataka are eligible to apply for this faculty development programmme.
- 2. The candidates who have under gone similar training/courses earlier are not eligible to apply again.

- 1. A total of 40 young faculty members in the social sciences disciplines will be selected from Government degree colleges, Government aided degree colleges and Private degree/PG colleges (on roll) in the state of Karnataka on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 2. The aspects like representation of different Social Science Disciplines, Social Background, Gender, etc., shall also be taken into consideration while selecting the candidates.
- 3. The applicants who are interested to participate may apply online by visiting our Website, ICSSR-SRC or Karnataka State Open University on or before the last date (i.e. 05/10/2023).
- 4. The selected outstation candidates will be provided with free accommodation and food during the course period.
- 5. Attendance is compulsory for all sessions throughout the Programme period, failing which, the certificate will not be issued..
- The selected candidates are required to bring the hardcopy of registration form and NOC from the Instition.
