Based on the Govt Order following shift -2 classes were started from the year 2007-2008. B. Sc Chemistry, B. Sc Computer Science, B.Com, B.B.A, B. Lit Tamil. Now 13 UG Courses, 9 PG Course and 7 Research Department currently running.
