2. The Ph.D. Research Scholars who have completed their Coursework examination / Part I and have registered for their Ph.D. from the Academic Year 2020-21 onwards are eligible to apply for this course work. The candidates must upload a PhD coursework certificate / Part-I Memo in the online application form.
3. The candidates who have under gone similar training courses earlier are not eligible to apply again.

2. The aspects like representation of different Social Science Disciplines, State, Gender, Social Background, etc., shall also be taken into consideration while selecting the Candidates.
3. The applicants who are interested to participate may apply online by clicking the link given below on or before the last date (i.e. **15th July, 2024**).
4. The Selected Outstation candidates will be provided with free accommodation and food during the course period. The Outstation participants will be reimbursed with the Sleeper Class Train (No Tatkal) fares/ Non A.C. Bus fares (Govt.) in shortest routes. However, the fellowship holders are not entitled to availing TA reimbursement.
