3. The paper should be prepared on A4 Sized paper using Times New Roman font (12 point size) with 1.5 line spacing. Preference must be formatted according to APA Style.
4. The Abstract (not exceeding 300 words) with 4 or 5 keywords and the full paper (not exceeding 10 pages) should be submitted by email to Selected Paper will be published as an Edited Volume with ISBN. Subject to adherence to the prescribed to plagiarism norms (Subject to additional charges).
5. An E-copy of the publication will be sent to the authors. Spot registration is also available (for participation) only.
